## **Peoria:**

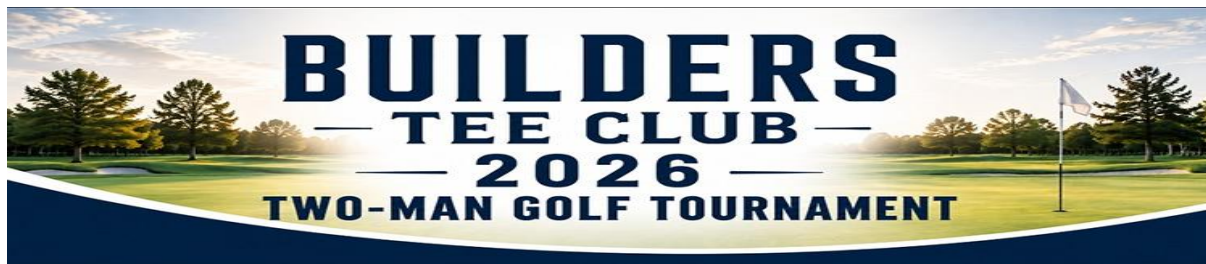
